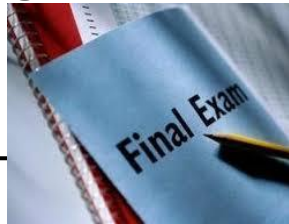
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# Testing for an Advanced Regents Diploma

\* Must also pass the final exam in French 3 or Spanish 3

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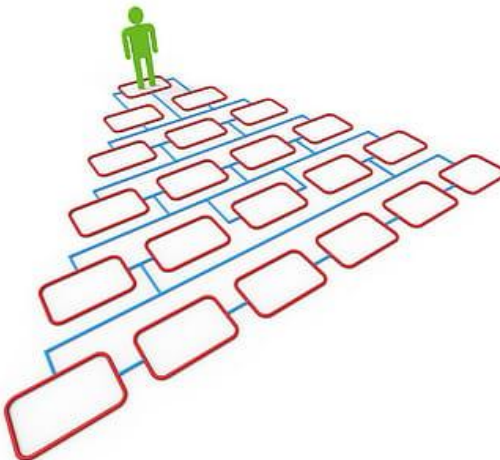
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# The Financial Aid Process
