Budget Proposal Approved

At its April 10 meeting, the Corinth Central School Board of Education approved a proposed 2018-19 budget in the amount of \$21,845,805. This represents an increase of 3.53% over the current year's budget.

The proposed budget includes a tax levy of \$9,200,000, which is a 2.78% increase (below the tax levy limit of 2.8%). A budget hearing will take place on May 8, 2018 at 6 p.m. in the auditorium at the Middle/High School building.

Job Fair a Success

Corinth participated in the Regional Schools Job Fair organized by WSWHE BOCES. Corinth Middle School Principal Eric Schenone represented Corinth at the job fair, and enjoyed meeting with job-seekers from around the region and beyond.
