**Budget Update**

The District received an additional \$150,000 from the Governor's proposal and the Board of Education will be adopting the Budget at the April 10 Board meeting. The proposed budget of \$21,897,805 represents a budget-to-budget increase of \$797,345, or 3.78%.

The Board of Education and administration are committed to developing a budget that remains within the tax cap, as it has for the past five years, while also maintaining opportunities for all students. The proposed tax levy of \$9,200,000 represents an increase of 2.78%. This is within the maximum allowable tax levy limit established for our district by New York state, which is calculated at 2.8%.

**Board of Education**

Petitions are still available for any district residents who may wish to run for a seat on the Corinth Central School District Board of Education. The district will have three open Board seats on the May 15 budget vote and annual election. If you are interested in running for the Board seat, please pick up a petition from the District Clerk in the Office of the Superintendent between the hours of 7:45 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays. You must be 18 years of age, must be a resident of the district and have lived in the district for 1 year prior to the election date, may not hold any other public office and may not reside with any other school board member of the same board and may not be a current employee of the school. A minimum of 25 signatures from district residents is needed from petitioners. Deadline for submission of completed petition is on or before 5 p.m. April 16, 2018.
