School Budget Vote

Corinth Central School District voters will consider a proposed budget for the 2018-19 school year of \$21,845,805 on Tuesday, May 15. This year's budget vote will be held at Corinth Elementary School and will coincide with the eighth annual Community Open House. Also on the ballot will be the following propositions

- Bus purchase
- Bus purchase reserve fund
- Corinth Free Library budget

Three candidates are seeking election to the Corinth Board of Education: Arthur Lozier III, Cheri Sullivan and Andy Kelley. There are two open seats, with five-year terms, and one two-year, unexpired term.
