

A special meeting of the Corinth Central School Board of Education was held February 25, 2021. President Lozier called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Board Member Roll Call: Vice President Freebern, Trustee Baker, Trustee Kelley, and Trustee Lueck; Absent: Trustee Bourdeau and Trustee Jenkins; Student Board Member: Ann Cook; Present: Mark Stratton, Superintendent, Susan Foley, Business Administrator; Jennifer Bardin, District Clerk; Also Present: Dan Miller, Sandra Dardanelli (BCA), Kyle Smith (BCA), Anthony Charoensook, Danielle Dingmon, Nikki Cutright, Michael Meade and Donna Briner.

Pledge of Allegiance: Those present were led in the Pledge of Allegiance by President Lozier.

Public Participation on agenda items was offered. There was none.

It was offered for Board questions in regards to the Window Contract Bid. Sue Foley gave a summary of the situation, stating that the bid opened Tuesday afternoon with two bids and the lowest bidder being Bast Hatfield at \$134,000. We have \$85,000 budgeted for the windows, the bid consisted of 16 windows, unit price was checked, architect went back and checked to see how many we can get under \$85,000 and make sure the windows they were looking at would qualify, when they would be available and a schedule of when they would be done. Lueck asked to remind him of which windows we are doing. Sue stated elementary, looking at 16 windows, to bring it down to 5 classes with 10 windows at the \$85,000. With Phase 4 that is with SED now we are looking to finish up the windows at elementary. Trustee Kelley asked if could reject and re bid or just leave alone, Sue stated do have that option. It was asked by Trustee Kelley if there will be the need of a clerk of the works for this project, Kyle and Sandy stated depends on how would want to handle it. Kyle stated that there will be a general contractor on the site. Sandy stated clerk not necessary however will want someone there to take pictures and make sure things are proceeding on schedule. Kyle stated that Bast Hatfield is asking to work a full 8 hour shift afterschool hours if possible. Stratton stated that he doesn't see a problem with that.

Business Items:

Window Contract Bid: A motion was made by Trustee Kelley second by Trustee Lueck and passed 5-0 to approve the awarding of window contract bid in the amount of \$134,000.

Fall 2 Season Sports: A motion was made by Trustee Baker second by Trustee Freebern and passed 5-0 approve Volleyball and Football for the Fall 2 Season, with the anticipated start date of March 8, 2021.
