Changes to the School Calendar

Due to the number of snow days used by school districts across the state this year, the NYS Education Department reviewed school district calendars and determined the need to clarify half days and the required 180 days of instruction students need to succeed. Subsequently, the State Aid Office determined that scheduled half days do not count toward the required 180 days of instruction.

As a result, the half days originally scheduled for Elementary students on Monday-Wednesday, June 19, 20, and 21, 2017 are now full days. Additionally, Thursday and Friday, June 22 and 23, 2017 will now be half-days for K-5 students.

Transportation and school meal schedules will be adjusted to reflect these changes.

Thank you for understanding our need to revise the calendar in order to ensure that students receive the amount of instruction they need to be successful and for the district to receive the State Aid it relies on.
